1. Purpose

Learn Without Limits CIC is committed to operating in an environmentally responsible way that is proportionate to the size, scope and stage of the organisation. We recognise our responsibility to minimise environmental impact while delivering our activities effectively and inclusively.

2. Our approach

We take a pragmatic, digital-first approach to reducing our environmental footprint. In practice, this means we aim to:

- prioritise digital communication and documentation wherever possible
- minimise printing and use double-sided printing when printing is necessary
- reuse materials such as display resources, signage and stationery
- recycle waste responsibly and in line with local arrangements
- select accessible community venues that minimise unnecessary travel
- use online meetings where this is effective and inclusive

3. Procurement and resources

Where practical and affordable, we will consider environmental impact when purchasing goods and services, including choosing durable items over disposable alternatives and avoiding unnecessary purchases. Environmental considerations will be balanced with accessibility, cost and suitability for our beneficiaries.

4. Monitoring and review

Environmental practice will be reviewed annually by the Board and strengthened as the organisation grows and resources allow.
