



Learning Without Limits CIC

Programme & Governance Update

January 2026

This update provides a public-facing summary of Learning Without Limits CIC's programme position as of January 2026. It builds directly on the unfunded research, consultation and proof-of-concept phase completed during 2025 and sets out the organisation's readiness to move into funded build and delivery.

Programme status

The research, engagement, scoping and proof-of-concept phase is now complete. No funded delivery took place during this period. Activity was intentionally limited to learning, testing viability, and shaping a programme grounded in lived experience and system gaps.

Readiness to commence build and delivery

Based on evidence gathered, Learning Without Limits CIC is now ready to commence structured build and phased delivery once appropriate funding is secured. Further exploratory work is not required before delivery begins.

Theory of Change

Learning Without Limits CIC's theory of change is based on prevention and early intervention. Families often disengage or escalate into crisis not due to lack of services, but due to fragmented systems, inaccessible information, and absence of early, navigable infrastructure.

By investing first in governed digital infrastructure, accurate information, and safe community spaces, families are supported earlier, escalation is reduced, and pressure on statutory services is eased. Longer-term outcomes are achieved by reopening progression pathways once stability is restored.

Governance and safeguarding

Governance structures and safeguarding principles are established and will underpin all delivery. The organisation will only move into delivery where roles are funded, supervision is in place, and safeguarding requirements can be met.

Funding position

The programme is designed to transition from a grant-supported build phase into diversified, values-aligned income streams over time. Build and delivery will commence only once funding is secured.
